ESOPHAGUS/BARIUM SWALLOW

EVALUATION OF: Swallowing difficulties

Chest pain

Sensation of food getting stuck

PREP: Nothing to eat or drink after midnight the day prior to appointment

until procedure is finished. If there is any possibility of pregnancy, this must be discussed with your physician BEFORE any tests can

be done.

PROCEDURE: The radiologist will give you barium to drink and multiple pictures

of you swallowing and your esophagus will be taken.

POST: Be sure to drink lots of water after the exam to flush the barium

through your digestive system.
